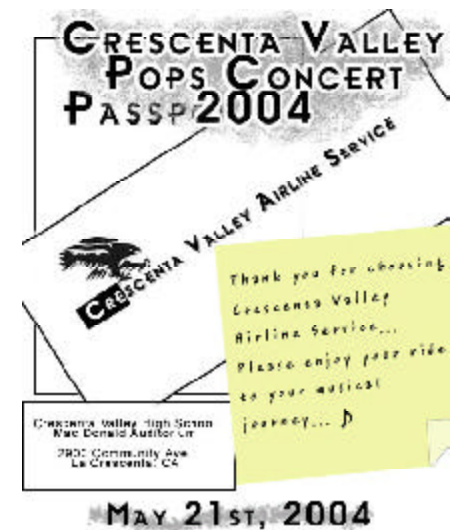

# CVHS Musical Journey Your Official Guide

*New York, New York* was the theme song for the movie of the same name directed by Martin Scorsese and starring Robert DeNiro and Liza Minnelli. The movie was a flop, but Liza Minnelli kept the song alive by singing it in her concerts. The song grew in popularity when Frank Sinatra recorded it in 1980.

*Birdland* is one of the most recognizable jazz pieces of the '70s because of its distinctive bassline. The original Birdland was a Jazz club in New York that was located on Broadway from 1949 -1965. It was known as the "Jazz Corner of the World" because Jazz musicians such as Charlie Parker, Dizzy Gillespie, Thelonious Monk, Miles Davis, John Coltrane, Bud Powell, Stan Getz, and many, others were frequent headliners. It was named after Charlie Parker because his Nickname was "Yardbird," or more simply, "the Bird."

*Copacabana* -These tropical and upbeat rhythms came straight out of Havana Cuba.

*A Thousand Miles* - this beautiful contemporary piece, written by Vanessa Carlton is a favorite among high school students. It is perfect description of how far we will be traveling on some of our Musical Journeys.

*What a Wonderful World* - This Louis Armstrong classic has been a favorite for years- reminding us of "skies of blue and clouds of white." Our world provides many places to travel on our Musical Journey.

Broadway in the 90's - Musical theater provides many opportunities to travel. While in New York on Broadway, we will travel to Africa with the Lion King, and take voyage on the Titanic.

*Selections from "Chicago"* - The hit musical and movie Chicago is inspired by the upbeat music of Dixieland, Ragtime, and Jazz of the 1920's.

*Pirates of the Caribbean* - We end our Journey in the breathtaking Caribbean where we'll take you on a fantastic adventure with the entire music department as they play this energetic and exciting piece from the Blockbuster movie of the same name. What journey wouldn't be complete without adventure, excitement, and the legendary *Pirates of the Caribbean!*

*Spirit of the American West* - Two contrasting themes unite in this western-style work demonstrating the hard working, yet spirited pioneers of the American West.

*Hotel California* presents a dynamic, exciting show saluting the mega-hits of The Eagles. *Hotel California* recreates that classic sound which undeniably transcends the boundaries of Rock, R&B and Country.

*Strawberry Fields* - A Beatles hit, which takes us right back to Liverpool London. This song will have you dreaming

*An Irish Party in Third Class* - Traveling to Ireland to listen and dance to traditional Irish Jigs.

*Rock This Town* - Each town has its own special, unique, and exciting quality. This Brian Setzer hit captures the character of a vibrant town.

*Girl from Ipanema* - The beautiful beaches in this Brazilian city make you feel like you're sitting there watching the native people stroll by.

*Chicago* - Take a journey through the "windy" and jazzy melodies of Chicago.

*Prairie Journal* - Saga of the Prairie - This song takes us on a trip through the grassy plains of America. Its unique sound is special to Copland's works. Listen for various styles of popular music throughout the song.

*Moscow Nights* - A traditional Russian folksong, giving the listener the feeling that they are walking through the streets of Moscow.

*Inchon* - Listen to helicopters in the distance as you enjoy this intense musical arrangement which depicts the events of the Korean War and the cultural importance of the Korean city of Inchon.

*Javanese* - Located in the Indonesian archipelago, the island of Java is home to a rich musical tradition of unique rhythms with an Asian background. This song by the French composer Claude Bolling attempts to mix the spirit of Java with the energy of Jazz.

*The Great Race* -The theme song to the movie of the same title was written by Henry Mancini and is a great way to get us moving along on our journey as we "race" from one place to another.

*Hawaii 5-0* - Aloha! The surf music that beats like the waves on Waikiki Beach is coming your way. This hit tune from the popular 1970's T.V. show of the same name will keep you entertained as the low brass keep the beat of the music. Meanwhile, the saxophones, trumpets and flutes add a splash of flavor to make one terrific smoothie of musical notes.

*Montego Bay* - A breathtaking, picturesque region along the coast in Jamaica. Being a divine city and coastal region on the shores of Jamaica, Montego Bay's combination of culture, the cosmopolitan resorts, and magnificent urban districts coalesce into the distinct island flavor that is part of Jamaica.
