

#### A SUFFICIENT AMOUNT OF MONEY SHOULD BE BROUGHT FOR THE FOLLOWING:

1. The following meals on your tour ARE INCLUDED: All participants will have Disney Meal Voucher Coupons

Breakfast:Friday, Saturday, Sunday & MondayDinner:Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday

Lunch: Friday, Saturday, Sunday

Participants must bring money for lunch on travel days. Note: No meals are served on flights.

2. MISC: A minimum of \$25.00 - \$35.00 per day should be brought for drinks, snacks, souvenirs, gifts, etc.

# LODGING INFORMATION

- 2. Room assignments have already been selected at school. Students are lodged four per room sharing two double size beds. Daily maid service is provided. Roll away beds are not available.
- 3. Students will be able to make long distance calls home to parents (collect or with a credit card only) from the chaperone's rooms. Individual room phones will not allow outgoing long distance calls. Cell phones are allowed however we assume no responsibility for loss, damage or usage (roaming or long distance charges).
- 4. For security and person safety students are not allowed to visit in other students' rooms. All socialization is to take place in the hotel common public areas (recreation room, food court, etc).
- 5. Our hotel food court, THE END ZONE, is open from 6:00 am until Midnight.
- 6. Our hotel has two swimming pools, (Surf Board Bay and Grand Slam Pool). Students may only swim when Lifeguards are on duty between 4:30 pm-11:00 pm. Please check with your teacher for swimming rules and NEVER SWIM ALONE.

# GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. You may bring MP3, CD players, etc. however we do require headphones or earphones to be used at all times. Each flight group will have a movie and requires headphones. Delta may charge for headset rental.... Bring your own
- All CVHS and New Horizon Tour policies will be enforced. Violations of rules may result in dismissal from tour, parents arranging for your trip home, and no tour refund. All participants have agreed to and signed code of conduct statements and are aware of the rules and consequences for violation.

#### DISNEY HAS STRICT CURFEW POLICIES FOR STUDENT GROUPS WHICH MUST BE FOLLOWED AT ALL TIMES ANY STUDENT IN VIOLATION OF CURFEW WILL BE DISMISSED FROM TOUR and SENT HOME at parents extra expense with no refund.

2. Please bring sunscreen, hat and sunglasses as Florida sun can be intense. Please check internet for weather conditions a few days in advance of trip and plan accordingly.
