Reminders and Safety Precautions

**Reminders**

- Arrive 30 minutes **PRIOR TO BOARDING TIME**
  - Bus 1 – 5:55 p.m. | Bus 2 – 7:55 p.m. | Bus 3 – 6:30 p.m.
- Bring Photo ID and **KEEP WITH YOU AT ALL TIMES**
- Bring Semi-Formal clothes to wear when we see **"CHICAGO."**
  - **Skirt, blouse, Slacks and Tie**
- Bring a Watch and cell phone (if nationwide)
- Mark all luggage and carry-ons with identification
- It WILL be cold in New York Pack accordingly
  - Friday H67-L45, Saturday H54-L36, and Sunday H53-L42.
- Make a packing list so you know what you've taken (instrument, bags, ect..)
- Sleep on the flight to New York. It is a "red-eye" and we have a huge day on Friday.
- After school Thursday take a shower and put on a fresh pair of clothes
- You are allowed 2 check-in Luggage items and one carry-on PLUS a purse or small bag (back-pack)
  - Small instruments count as one carry-on (flute, clarinet, trumpet, violin)
  - Large instruments count as one check-in (Anything else)
- "You pack it – you carry it"

**Safety Precautions**

- Travel in groups at all times – NEVER BE ALONE AT ANY TIME
- Do not talk to strangers (no matter how appealing they may look)
- Do NOT travel on the Subway or enter the Subway stations
- Stay within the predetermined parameters whenever you leave the bus.
  - To be announced at each location
- A Chaperone will always be stationed at a predetermined spot whenever we leave the bus
- Each Chaperone will have a Walkie-Talkie and a cell phone.
- We will set a predetermined location to meet at the Hotel if there is an evacuation
- Carry your Cell phone with you at all times. Share your number with your chaperone.

  - He will receive daily updates on the trip status
- Be EARLY to all set meeting times. Do NOT be LATE.
- Follow all instructions from your Room Leaders, Chaperones, Bus Captains, and Mr. Schick
