2. **PLEASE ARRIVE AT LEAST 35 MINUTES EARLY** to facilitate check-in and loading. **Buses will Depart on Time.** Your bus will have a number posted inside the front door window for easy identification. Please check-in with your school sponsor or bus captain/leader upon arrival.

***Please remain on the same bus throughout the tour.***

3. Upon arrival at the bus, please place your luggage in the proper storage bay of your assigned bus. ***Each person is responsible for the loading, retrieval and carrying of their own luggage and instrument(s) throughout the tour.***

4. Each person is limited to ONE suitcase and ONE small carry on bag plus their musical instrument. **All participants should bring warm, weather proof clothing & jacket as seasonal San Diego weather may be unpredictable.** It is better to have appropriate clothing for inclement weather (i.e. warm coat/ jacket, umbrella,) and not have to use it, than it is to not have it ***and need it.***

### DON'T FORGET YOUR CONCERT PERFORMANCE ATTIRE

Note: The recommended dress for Sea World, picnic dinner and the awards presentation is casual.

5. Please store any carry-on items (jackets, sweaters, books or magazines and any small hand luggage) in the racks above your seat inside the bus. Participants will not have access to luggage loaded in storage bays of bus until arrival at hotel.

6. **Please make sure that all luggage, carry on items, instruments and personal items are clearly marked with a name tag inside and outside.**

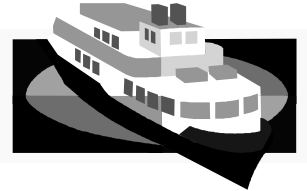
### FINANCIAL INFORMATION



A SUFFICIENT AMOUNT OF MONEY SHOULD BE BROUGHT FOR THE FOLLOWING:

- Most meals on your tour are included:** three buffet breakfasts & four dinners are provided. **Participants must bring money for lunch on Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and Monday.** Participants are encouraged to bring snacks on board the bus to eat between meals.
- SOUVENIRS:** We recommend you bring \$10.00 - \$20.00 per day for souvenirs, gifts, posters, T-shirts, snacks, etc. **All exhibit & activity entries during trip are included.**

### LODGING INFORMATION

- Final room / unit assignments will be confirmed enroute. Students are lodged four per room sharing two queen size beds. All linens are provided. Please note roll away beds are **not available**.
- Our hotel has an outdoor swimming pool for your enjoyment...*bring a suit!* Actual swim time availability will depend upon schedule and seasonal weather conditions. Hotel will provide one shower towel per participant; **it is advisable to bring an additional large towel with you if you plan on swimming.**  
**STUDENTS MAY ONLY SWIM at SCHEDULED TIMES when TEACHERS ARE PRESENT AT POOL**
- Participants will be able to make long distance calls home (collect or with a credit card only) from the chaperones' rooms. **All calls home should be made collect/charged so that the hotel will not bill tour participants directly.** Cellular phones are permitted however we assume no responsibility for these items.
- Students are **not** allowed to visit/socialize in other students' rooms at any time. Students may socialize in common areas of hotel until curfew.



### GENERAL INFORMATION



- You may bring digital music players, and electronic games however we do require earphones to be used at all times. We prefer no portable video players or laptop computers. Your teachers, chaperones, bus drivers, Tour Company, etc. are not to be blamed or held responsible if your property is lost, damaged or stolen.
- All school and tour policies will be enforced. Violations of rules may result in dismissal from tour, parents arranging for your trip home, and no tour refund.** All participants are required to have a signed "New Horizon Tour "Agreement/Release" form on file, in addition to school forms, prior to boarding.
- If you plan to bring a **camera**...bring the portable type, disposable Kodak "Fun Saver" or the "Fling" Cameras.
- Our bus is equipped with a **VHS or DVD system** to enjoy movies as we travel. Due to copyright laws movies are not provided by the bus company or New Horizon Tours. Because buses are not assigned to a trip until 24 hrs prior to departure we cannot designate movie format in advance. **We encourage students to bring a favorite movie from home in both formats that are rated for general audience viewing. Absolutely no R rated movies. ALL MOVIES MUST BE SUBMITTED TO MR. SCHICK FOR APPROVAL IN ADVANCE.**
