#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- We are a large group and it is critical you follow the time schedule to prevent delays to the entire group. Please show patience and tolerance when waiting to board buses, activities, meals, elevators etc. We have tried to stagger group movements whenever possible to minimize delays.
- 2. All phone calls from hotel rooms MUST be made collect or by using a credit card.
- 3. All participants are reminded that you are a *GUEST* at the hotel, in restaurants and at all parks. Please be courteous and respectful as you represent the CVHS music program.
- Hotel policies require that there be no running, yelling or congregating in the halls or rooms at any time. All socialization is to take place in public areas of hotel (lobby, poolside, recreation room, etc).
- Each room must be left in good condition upon departure. Each Room Is Inspected Prior To
  Departure and Fees Collected From Students for any Damage or Extra Cleaning Necessary to
  Restore the Room to its Normal Condition.
- 6. NEVER CLIMB OVER, JUMP OFF, OR PLAY AROUND ON HOTEL BALCONIES.
- 7. We have a private evening security guard in our hotel to patrol hotel floors where student rooms are located. Any excessive noise or curfew violations will be reported by the guards to chaperones.
  IT MUST BE ABSOLUTELY QUIET in THE HOTEL ROOMS AFTER 10:00 P.M.
- 8. Never go anywhere alone!!! ALWAYS BE IN A GROUP OF THREE (3) OR MORE.

  All CVHS and New Horizon Tour policies will be enforced. Violations of rules may result in dismissal from tour, parents arranging for your trip home, and no tour refund.

  All participants have agreed to and signed code of conduct statements, and are aware of the rules and consequences for violation.

OUR HOTEL HAS STRICT CURFEW POLICIES FOR STUDENT GROUPS WHICH MUST BE FOLLOWED ANY STUDENT IN VIOLATION OF CURFEW WILL BE DISMISSED FROM TOUR and SENT HOME at parents extra expense with no refund.

- Never go swimming without chaperone permission and a lifeguard present. Students may only swim when given by permission by chaperones and an adult is present. Check with your teacher for swimming rules and <u>NEVER SWIM ALONE</u>.
- 10. ALL TRAVEL WILL BE IN YOUR CVHS GROUPS on private chartered buses.
- 11. You are responsible for loading, unloading and storage of your belongings and musical instruments. We assume no responsibility for the safety and security of your belongings or instruments.
