Suggested items to bring and last minute details.

PACK LIGHT – This is a 4-day, 3-night trip.  
You are responsible for carrying your own luggage AND instrument.

**Items to Remember:**

- Instrument, case, music (put a card inside you case with your (or the schools) name, address and phone #)
- CONCERT DRESS - Black and white. Shoes and socks. (Skirts must be 6 inches below the knee)
- Pants and Shorts (plan for both hot and cool weather – check the weather in San Francisco/Monterey before you leave)
- Shirts
- Casual / Dress clothes for the dinner/dance/awards ceremony (to be held outside)
- Underwear
- Shoes (remember black dress shoes for the performance and a pair of walking shoes)
- Socks and Pantyhose (Black socks for performance and everyday use)
- Shampoo/Conditioner
- DEODORANT
- Soap and other toiletries
- Glasses or Contact Lenses
- Toothbrush/Toothpaste
- DEODORANT
- Hair Products (i.e. Blow Dryers, etc.)
- Film/Camera (bring in carry-on luggage)
- Sunscreen
- DEODORANT
- Cell Phone and Charger if applicable or pre-paid calling card (NO calls from rooms!)
- Camera (battery charger for digital cameras)
- A watch
- Cash for lunches (approx. \$6.00 per day) Cash for souvenirs (Approx. \$20.00 day)

\*Students can bring iPods, portable game systems (pgs), playing cards, etc. at their own risk. They can only be used during bus rides, free time, and inside the hotel room.

\*If a student uses a cell phone, headphones, ipods, pgs, and playing cards during announcements OR in the concert auditorium, it will be confiscated by chaperones and returned to parents upon return.

- Chaperones can enter a room unannounced if they see/hear/smell anything suspicious. (Remember, when you are on a school field trip, anywhere you are becomes "school grounds" and all the "school rules" apply!)
