LAS VEGAS SPRING TRIP

Suggested items to bring and last minute details.

This is a 4-day, 3-night trip. You are responsible for carrying your own luggage AND instrument.
Be at School at 7:15 a.m. on Thursday, April 12th

Items to Remember:

- Instrument, case, music (put a card inside you case with your (or the schools) name, address and phone #)
- CONCERT DRESS – Specific for YOUR group
 - Guys - Black dress shoes (**no sneakers**), black socks, black pants, white *long* sleeve dress shirt; long tie (any color). **Black Sport Jacket is required.** (**Symphony guys:** Tuxedo shirt and tie)
 - Girls - Black dress or black skirt with modest white blouse. (**Symphony ladies:** Sym Uniform long black dress). Both dress and skirt must be at least 6 inches **below the Knee when sitting down. NO SLITS.** Black dress shoes (**no flip flops**)
 - **Jazz Band** - Formal – black pants, black dress shirt, black socks and shoes, black tie
- **If you have a music department polo bring it on the bus for the Agassi Academy performance. If not please wear a blue shirt! Something you can quickly slip on!**
- Pants and Shorts (plan for primarily mildly warm weather, but dress in layers because it may get warm/hot at times; and then cool in the evenings – check the weather in Las Vegas, Nevada before you leave)
- Shirts
- Warm Jacket for evenings, Hat
- Underwear
- CONCERT DRESS – see above!
- Shoes (a pair of walking shoes)
- Socks
- Shampoo/Conditioner – (Pack for your Room)
- Soap and other toiletries
- Glasses or Contact Lenses
- Toothbrush/Toothpaste - Pack for your Room
- DEODORANT
- Hair Products (i.e. Blow Dryers, etc.) (Pack for your Room)
- **SUNSCREEN – LOTS!!! WEAR IT!!!**
- DEODORANT
- Cell Phone and Charger if applicable or pre-paid calling card (NO calls from rooms!)
- Camera/Memory Card (battery charger for digital cameras)
- Cash for lunches (approx. \$15.00 per day) Cash for souvenirs (Approx. \$20.00 day)
- CONCERT DRESS – see above

*Students can bring iPods, portable game systems (pgs), playing cards, etc. at their own risk. They can only be used during bus rides, free time, and inside the hotel room. **NOT at the performance Venue.**

*If a student uses a cell phone, headphones, iPods, pgs, and playing cards during announcements OR in the performance Venue, it will be confiscated by chaperones and returned to parents upon return.

*****We are not responsible for lost or stolen items*****

- Chaperones can enter a room unannounced if they see/hear/smell anything suspicious. (Remember, when you are on a school field trip, anywhere you are becomes "school grounds" and all the "school rules" apply!)
